

Leadership Fredericksburg

Leadership Fredericksburg is a nine-month program for a select group of leaders in the Fredericksburg region to:

- Enhance their leadership development skills;
- meet with top community leaders;
- complete a personality profile assessment;
- receive a 360° rater leadership assessment which includes a one-on-one executive coaching session;
- work directly with an individual mentor from the business community; and
- participate in team projects.

Through monthly sessions, team projects, and interaction with community decision-makers, **Leadership Fredericksburg** develops leaders with vision and commitment to their workplace and the community.

Eligibility

Individuals who have demonstrated a capacity for leadership, a record of community service and a willingness to commit time to the LF '25 program are encouraged to apply.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Must have an established connection to the Fredericksburg Region
- Must show evidence of leadership in the workplace and in the community
- Must be willing to commit the required time to the program
- Must be committed to utilizing their leadership skills and knowledge for the long-term benefit of the community
- Must attend the opening session on September 20th, 2024 and both the class session and graduation ceremony on May 16, 2025

Important Application Dates:

Tuesday, July 1st, 2024: Applications Deadline **Second week of August 2024:** Chamber announces all accepted applicants. (*All applicants will be notified of acceptance prior to the announcement*)

Program Schedule

Classes meet on the **third Friday** monthly, September through May from 9am-5pm, except for the months of December and April. In these months the the class will meet on the **second Friday** as to not conflict with holidays:

- Project Presentations occur on **Thursday, May 8, 2025, 3 PM** **Time outside of regular class* sessions is required in preparation of participant's team project. Fellows are encouraged to participate in their team's presentation.

- Fellows are expected to attend all sessions; one full session absence or its equivalent (*leave early/arrive late*) is allowed. <u>No exceptions</u>. *Opportunities for extra credit to make up time are offered.

- 2. A resume may be used in lieu of answering the employment history and prior education questions.
- 3. Feel free to consult with Leadership Fredericksburg (LF) alumni as you complete the application. Call the Chamber office at 540-373-9400 for additional questions.
- 4. **Include a photo** of yourself with your application package.
- 5. Complete all answers and if there is a reason that a specific question is not applicable, please explain the reason.

- 7. Include \$30 application fee with application and supporting documents.

8. Each section is weighted; you are advised to complete the full application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Fellows that are **absent more than one full-day (or equivalent**) from the monthly sessions will not be permitted to graduate.
